STUDENT SATISFACTION FEEDBACK SURVEY 2020-21

As part of the process improvement initiative, the IQAC of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Degree College, Gonda administered a survey in the month of March 2020-21 that evaluates student satisfaction with the college.

It will provide opportunities to monitor changes across the years in a range of ways.

This report presents a summary of results, in addition to a comparison with previous year's survey results.

Objectives

- To measure students' level of satisfaction with the college as a whole, and with its different processes.
- To evaluate the effect of changes initiated this year on student satisfaction with the process.
- To identify existing problems, if any, and recommend changes.
- To identify changes in student satisfaction with various processes, as compared with previous surveys.

Methods and tools

The Student Satisfaction Feedback Survey was prepared using, in general, the same guidelines adopted for previous similar surveys (Appendix). The 30 survey questions have been developed in light of existing college practices. A comment box has been provided for students to add any relevant written comments on learning and teaching at the college. The expectation is that college will retain this open text data and use it for their own analysis.

The Survey included the following components:

- Global items measuring students' overall satisfaction with the process.
- Items soliciting student opinion and perception of the quality of the programs, classrooms and laboratories.
- Items soliciting student opinion and perception of the Syllabus and Examination process.
- Items soliciting student opinion and perception of the Teaching environment and material.

• Items soliciting student opinion and perception of the Infrastructure and maintenance.

The total number of students enrolled in graduate and postgraduate courses for the 2020-21 academic year is 7162. 716 undergraduate and Post-graduate students from all classes, or 10% of the total enrolment for the 2020-21 academic year, made up the first sample. We conducted the study using cluster and easy sampling approaches. The data from 2020-21 is summarized in the following tables. The number of students enrolled in the 2020-21 academic year was 7162. As a result, we have taken an approximation of 716 students. **Table 1**



Data Analysis and interpretation



The interpretations are as follows as per the questions given-


1. Entire course completed at time





Results & Conclusions

The results drawn from two surveys regarding overall view of students for college campus, facilities provided and faculty cooperation as well as the other about the syllabus design and review is as follows-

Overall feedback from students

For overall feedback from students we have used a structured questionnaire having 30 questions about the faculty cooperation, facilities provided in the college etc. The results are being interpreted in the form of graphs and charts which shows that-

- i. More than 67% students agreed for entire course completion on time and availability & accessibility of teachers after lectures.
- ii. More than 54% agreed that teachers take their lectures on time and regularly and come well prepared for class and are better in terms of providing content and style.
- iii. More than 36% of students agreed for providing material inputs and encouraging participation of students, providing basic physical resources in playground and laboratories, availability of books and basic amenities in library.
- iv. Approximately more than 47% of students agreed that teachers are friendly and helpful and use modern techniques for teaching, keep record of their attendance, guide for their holistic development and increase their knowledge and skills and give regular and timely feedback on performance and achievement of students.
- v. More than 49% students agreed for cooperation and support of library staff, grievance cell and disciplinary committee in college.

The following suggestions are provided by the students for the academic year 2020-2021 are given below.

- Suggested to provide ICT enabled classrooms.
- Virtual lab can be created to learn anywhere at any time.
- Online teaching can be effectively implemented through digital tools and techniques.

The responses collected for course end survey and feedback questionnaire are analyzed at department level and institution level. Further the discussions are made in board of studies meeting and IQAC meeting respectively, and appropriate actions are taken.
