Firstly, it aims to reduce traffic accidents, acknowledging the significant impact such incidents have on individuals and communities. Secondly, it seeks to minimize fatalities and injuries resulting from road accidents, recognizing the need to prioritize human life and wellbeing. Additionally, the policy aims to enhance road infrastructure and information dissemination, making roads safer and more efficient for all users.
